Papers are invited on the topics outlined and others falling within the scope of the meeting. Abstracts of no more than 300 words should be submitted **as soon as possible**. We strongly encourage the submission of abstracts online.

Abstracts should clearly state the purpose, results and conclusions of the work to be described in the final paper. Final acceptance will be based on the full-length paper, which if accepted for publication, must be presented at the conference. To be fair to all participants, each registered delegate will only be able to submit one paper.

The language of the conference will be English.

JOURNAL SUBMISSION

Delegates attending Water Resources Management 2011 will be invited to submit an expanded version of their paper for publication in the **International Journal of Sustainable Development and Planning**, associated with the Wessex Institute of Technology.

OPEN ACCESS

Situated between Los Angeles and San Bernardino, Riverside established itself as the birthplace of the Southern California citrus growing industry in the early twentieth century and has since developed into a dynamic metropolitan area. A wide variety of museums, parks and performing arts venues can be found in the city, offering events throughout the year. The historic centre contains many early twentieth century houses and an impressive civic centre, designed by a planner later responsible for San Francisco's civic centre. Mount Rubidoux and Box Springs National Park on the edge of the city offer many opportunities for walking and outdoor activities as well as panoramic views.

Water Resources Management 2011 will take place at the Mission Inn Hotel, a unique historic hotel not only notable in the town of Riverside but also recognised as both a Californian and National Historic monument.
