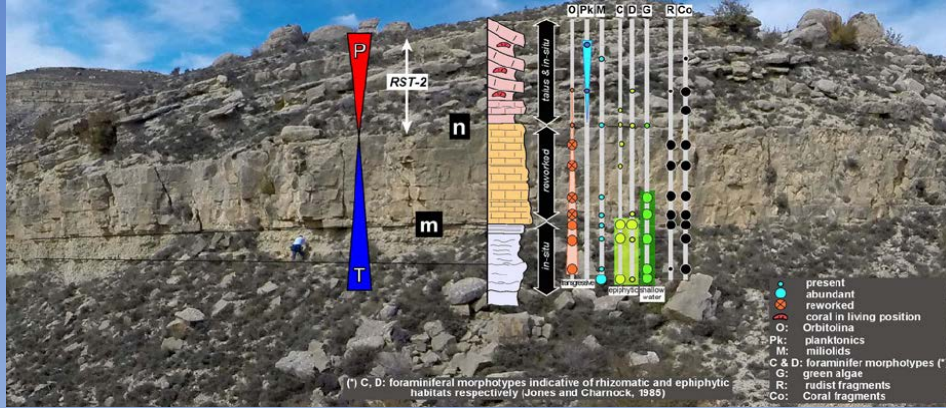

Why are carbonates so difficult to predict?

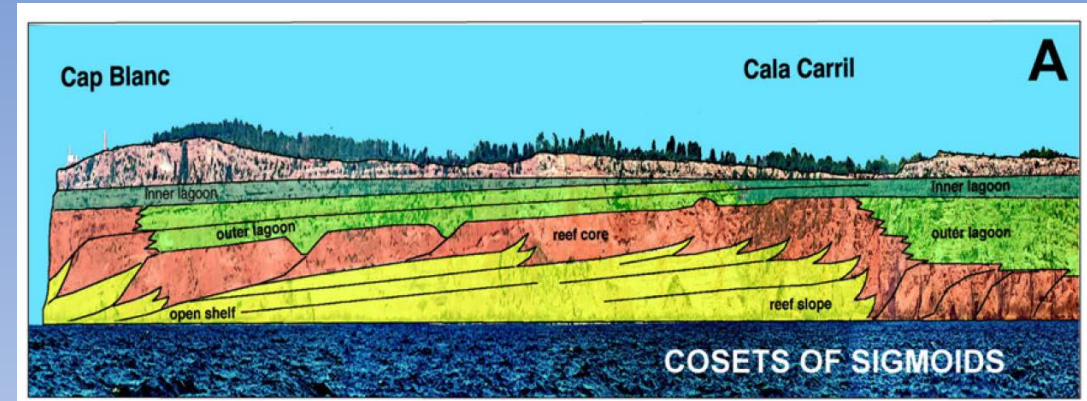
Carbonates are born, not made
