

INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

pursuant to art. 13 of Regulation (EU) 679/2016

The Italian Geological Society (hereinafter the "**Society**"), with registered office in Rome, Piazzale Aldo Moro, 5 and Tax Code 80258790585, as data controller, informs you, pursuant to art. 13 of European Regulation 679/2016 on the protection of personal data ("GDPR"), about the processing of your personal data that will be carried out by the writer.

1. Type of processed data

The **Society** is the owner of the processing of personal data communicated by the User and include:

Name and family name, Fiscal Code (tax code), address, e-mail, phone number, curriculum vitae.

The **data** are processed solely by the **Society** and are neither provided to private third parties nor used for profiling and/or promotional activities.

The use of the data is strictly related to the fulfilments of the Scientific Award evaluation.

2. Purpose of the treatment

Data processing is carried out by the **Society** for carrying out its activities. In particular, the Data provided by the Interested will be processed, with or without computerized tools, for the following purposes:

1) transmission of the application to the members of the Award Committee and required by law.

3. Treatment Modes

The **Data** will be processed by the **Society** with electronic and manual systems according to the principles of fairness, loyalty and transparency provided for by the applicable legislation on the protection of personal data and protecting the confidentiality of the interested party through technical and organizational security measures to ensure an adequate level of security.

4. Data retention

The **Data** provided by the interested party will be processed for the duration of the evaluation and competition, but if winner his name will be posted in the media of the Society indicating the list of winners. Thus the duration of the retention of data is defined as follow.

Start date: date of issuance of notice.

Duration criterion: Criterion Determination Period.

Criterion duration: The period of treatment is to be considered indefinite.

5. Communication, Dissemination and Transfer of Data

The **Data** will be processed, to the extent necessary, by authorized, adequately instructed and trained personnel, by the Society as well as by the personnel of third parties that provide services



to the **Society** and carry out processing of Data on behalf of and on instructions from the latter as data processors.

More generally, for carrying out its ordinary activities, the **Data** may be communicated to subjects who carry out control, auditing and certification activities carried out by the **Society**, consultants and freelance professionals in the context of tax and judicial assistance services and in the case of corporate transactions for which it is necessary to evaluate the company assets, public bodies and administrations, as well as persons entitled by law to receive such information, Italian and foreign judicial authorities and other public authorities, for purposes related to the fulfilment of legal obligations, or for the fulfilment of obligations assumed and arising from the contractual relationship, including for legal defence purposes.

The data collected will not be transferred to countries outside the EU.

6. Profiling and/or automatic processing activities

The collected data will not be profiled or processed automatically.

7. Other subjects related to the treatment

Owner and eventual representative in the EU: There is no EU representative for the holder

Co-Owner: There is no co-owner for the treatment(s) in question.

Responsible of the treatment: General Segretar

Dpo: No DPO/RDP will be appointed for the treatment(s) in question.

8. What are the rights of the interested party

The interested party may exercise, in relation to the processing of data described therein, the rights provided for by GDPR (Articles 15-21), including:

- 1) receive confirmation of the existence of the **Data** and access their content (access rights);
- 2) update, modify and/or correct the **Data** (right of correction);
- 3) request the deletion or limitation of **Data** processed in violation of the law including those that do not need to be kept for the purposes for which the Data was collected or otherwise processed (right to be forgotten and right to limitation);
- 4) oppose the processing (right of opposition);
- 5) make a complaint to the Supervisory Authority (Guarantor for the protection of personal data www.garanteprivacy.it) in case of violation of the regulations on the protection of **personal data**;
- 6) receive a copy in electronic format of the **Data** concerning him/her as the **Data** Subject, when such **Data** have been rendered in the context of the contract and request that such Data be are transmitted to another data controller (right to data portability).
