Abstracts must be written in English using Microsoft Word and contain up to 2000 words, including title, authors, affiliations and keywords, and up to 3 figures and 5 references. They will be available in the Abstracts book of the conference and may be published in ProGEO News for those who wish so. A special issue of the journal Geoheritage is under consideration for the works presented at the conference.
