NETWORKING, OUTREACH AND PRESENTING STRATEGIES

Background

Most science and engineering students are taught during school and undergraduate studies how to present their research and results in an academic environment. Regardless, many may encounter difficulties when attempting to transmit their ideas in a more industry related environment or to a non-scientifically trained audience.

It is not only enough to be expert in your research field, it is also important to network and outreach in order to find opportunities for postgrad studies openings and scholarship position; this is valid as well for those interested in following a career in industry after graduation.

Tasks and Objectives

This workshop will provide tips and tricks in a humble attempt to help young researchers with their future carriers, as they realize that mastering science communication is a required ability beyond the academic environment.

Through case studies it will be showed how to deliver a presentation in front of different types of audience.

Participants will be encouraged to present and should be open to receive feedback on their presenting skills. The workshop will encourage students to hone their networking skills, to improve their exposure in the scientific community and get the attention from headhunters in the industry.

Instructions for participants

Each participant should prepare a 10-minute presentation about their research. The corresponding PowerPoint file must be sent no later than **April 10, 23:59h** to: george.donoso@geo.uu.se.

Sending the presentation file before the deadline is mandatory in order to obtain a participation certificate.
