Nowadays, Director of the Department for Earth and Environmental Sciences and Chair of Mineralogy and Petrology at the Ludwig-Maximilians-University Munich.

His research has been focused on magma rheology and experimental volcanology with particular attention on experimental investigations of the physics and chemistry of magmas and melts, and their volcanological, geochemical and petrological significance. Accounting for more than 450 papers on indexed journals and awarded by many international scientific society for his outstanding scientific carrier, he held the role of Secretary General of the European Research Council from Sept 2011 to Dec 2013.
